Fearing that Plaintiff plans to use the above-captioned case to conduct premature discovery in the related 10-CV-2552-IEG (WVG) case and to gain undue advantage in that case, Defendants seek a protective order to prevent Plaintiff from taking various depositions and from conducting further written discovery. Defendants accordingly seek a temporary stay of discovery until after a ruling on their motion for a more definite statement in the 2010 case and so that overlapping discovery in the two related cases may be better coordinated. Plaintiff argues that a discovery stay of any length is not necessary. The Court held a telephonic hearing and heard oral arguments on March 22, 2011. After considering the moving

1 papers, oral arguments, and consulting the Honorable Irma E.
2 Gonzalez, the Court orders as follows:

3 (1) All discovery shall immediately be stayed, pending the outcome
4 of Defendants' motion to dismiss or for a more definite statement in
5 the 2010 case, but in no event for more than 60 days from March 22,
6 2011;

7 (2) The expert discovery deadline set in Docket No. 142 is vacated;


8 (3) The fact discovery deadline set in Docket No. 80 is vacated; and

9 (4) Within 24 hours of Judge Gonzalez's ruling on Defendants'
10 motion, the parties shall contact the undersigned's chambers to
11 schedule a status conference, at which time the Court will discuss
12 the posture of the case and setting discovery deadlines, if
13 appropriate.

14 The Court will defer ruling on Plaintiff's motion to compel
15 in the 11-CV-270-IEG(WVG) case until discovery resumes.

16 IT IS SO ORDERED.
