The Court convened a telephonic discovery hearing on June 27, 2011, to resolve a dispute regarding paragraph 9 of their forthcoming proposed protective order. Having made certain findings and rulings on the record, the Court issued a schedule to guide the parties in their efforts to revise the proposed paragraph. The following schedule governs:

On or before July 5, 2011: Defendants shall send Plaintiff a revised draft of the proposed paragraph 9. The revised draft shall be consistent with the Court's findings in the hearing.

On or before July 11, 2011: The parties shall have reviewed, revised, and conferred about the changes made to paragraph 9. If a dispute still remains, the parties shall contact the Court for assistance. If the parties have agreed on the language, they shall submit a proposed protective order for the Court's review, and shall also comply with the schedule below as the Court reviews and issues the protective order.

Assuming that the parties agree on paragraph 9's wording and submit a proposed order to the Court, by July 15, 2011, Defendant(s) shall propound to Plaintiff one (1) special interrogatory that seeks the information discussed in the hearing.

- Plaintiff shall respond within 30 days and shall serve his response by same-day courier, or other, service.
- Defendant(s) shall then have 3 business days from the date of receipt to review Plaintiff's response, object, and meet and confer if they object to Plaintiff's response.
- If any dispute over Plaintiff's response has not been resolved by the end of the third day, the parties shall then bring the dispute to the Court's attention within 8 business days from the day Defendant(s) received Plaintiff's response.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
